Location: Lane Elementary School, 7137 Beulah Street, Alexandria, VA 22315

Times: Seller set-up is between 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. The actual times of the sale are 7:00 a.m. - 2:30 p.m. Sellers must stop all sales at 2:30pm and leave the property clean no later than 3:00pm.

Cost: As always it is free to shop. The cost is \$15 per space to sell. All registration will be conducted on site, the day of the event. There will be no pre-registration this year.

Attendance and Promotion: The sale usually attracts a large number of shoppers. The Jaycees also place advertisements in local papers. Roadside signs will be placed in the area one week in advance.

Rain Dates: In the event of rain please call the event line at 703-866-7171 for up-to-date information.

Terms & Conditions: No food or beverages may be sold by anyone except the Alexandria Jaycees. The Jaycees will have a concessions table and grill for food and drinks, such as sodas, hotdogs, hamburgers, snacks, and bottled water.

Trash Clean Up: All sellers are responsible for cleaning up their trash and leaving the parking space in the same condition, which they found it. This includes removing all unsold items, empty boxes, and trash. Sellers who do not clean their space will be charged a \$25 clean-up fee. Sellers must haul away their own trash.

How to Obtain a Selling Space: Please show up at the sale the morning of the sales. Spaces are allotted at a first come, first serve basis. All participants must comply with the *Community Yard Sale Rules of Conduct*. Violating any of these rules may result in being denied participation in any current or future Alexandria Jaycees Community Yard Sale.

About the Alexandria Jaycees: The Jaycees is short for Junior Chamber of Commerce. We are a leadership training through community service organization for people between the ages of 21 - 40. We have helped such local charities/community groups as Carpenter's Shelter, the Red Cross, and Rebuilding Together. Our chapter is well known for the Christmas Shopping Tour for underprivileged youth, Christmas Tree Sales and our annual Community Appreciation Night honoring outstanding Alexandria public servants.

Alexandria Jaycees Community Yard Sale
Rules of Conduct

Please read these rules carefully. By attending a Community Yard Sale, all sellers must agree to comply with these rules. Violating any of these rules may result in being denied participation in any current or future Alexandria Jaycees Community Yard Sale.

1. All sellers must act in a courteous and professional manner while participating in this event.
2. Sellers may only set up on the designated parking lot on the date and during the time authorized by the Alexandria Jaycees. Failure to comply with this rule will result in the seller being barred permanently from future Community Yard Sales, as well as facing potential legal action by the property owners and/or the Alexandria Jaycees, Inc.
3. Sellers should not arrive before 6:00 am. Sales may not commence before 7:00 am on the day of the sales and must be completed by 2:30pm.
4. All trash and unsold items must be removed from the property by the seller no later than 3:00pm on the day of the yard sale. Failure to do this will result in a cleaning up fee of \$25, and possible banishment from future Community Yard Sales.
5. Sellers may not park their vehicles within the sale area during the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.
6. The Alexandria Jaycees reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to deny participation in, and access to, the Community Yard Sale to any individual with or without reason.
7. To the extent possible, sellers may select a space of their choice within the sale site. Spaces will be available on a first come, first served basis. However, the Alexandria Jaycees reserve the right to assign all spaces and to relocate sellers if required. Sellers can only sell from the actual space rented.
8. Sellers shall not contact the property owners (Fairfax County Public Schools) or their representatives for the purpose of obtaining permission to sell their wares. The property owners will not allow any one else to sell on their property if not part of the Alexandria Jaycees Community Yard Sale, and only then during the times set by the Alexandria Jaycees. ANY and ALL correspondence (oral or written) concerning participation in the Community Yard Sale must be directed to the Alexandria Jaycees via the 24-hour event line, 703-866-7171, e-mail yardsale@alexjaycees.org, or US mail: P.O. Box 1836, Alexandria, VA 22313. Sellers or customers may not attempt to contact an individual member in the Alexandria Jaycees, unless specifically authorized by that person.
9. Only authorized members of the Alexandria Jaycees may act as agents of the Alexandria Jaycees. Use of the Alexandria Jaycees name and/or reputation by any individual or organization not expressly authorized by the Alexandria Jaycees is strictly forbidden. Violators of this rule will face possible legal action by the Alexandria Jaycees, Inc.
10. Sellers are responsible for reporting and paying any applicable sales tax to the appropriate state and/or local jurisdictions.

11. In the event the sale is postponed due to rain, a telephone announcement will be placed by 6:00 AM on the event line, 703-866-7171.

We thank you for following these rules. If you notice anyone violating the above-mentioned rules or acting in an inappropriate manner, please notify the Alexandria Jaycees immediately. The property owners (Fairfax County Public Schools) allow us to use their property for this event. Therefore, it is important that everyone follows the rules and respect the property so that we may have more Community Yard Sales at this location!
